


# **Laptop Stand - Height Adjustable**

## **Product Diagram (LTSTND)**

**Angled View** 



Part		Function
1	Top Plate	• A platform for a <b>Laptop</b>
2	Upper Leg	<ul> <li>Attaches to the <b>Top Plate</b></li> <li>Configurable with three height-adjustment settings</li> </ul>
3	Cable-Management Slots	Organize and route <b>Cables</b>
4	Lower Leg	<ul> <li>Attaches to the Upper Leg</li> </ul>
5	Height-Adjustment Knob	<ul> <li>Secure the Upper Legs and Lower Legs together</li> <li>Can be removed to adjust height settings</li> </ul>

• Clean, Flat, and Stable Surface x 1



### Installation


Assembly

- 1. Place the **Top Plate**, top side down, onto a **Clean, Flat, and Stable Surface**.
  - **Note:** The lip on the **Top Plate** can overhang off the edge of the **Surface** for a level installation.
- 2. Place the **Upper Legs** onto the **Top Plate**. Ensure the **Holes** in the **Upper Legs** are aligned with the **Threaded Posts** on the **Top Plate**. The slanted portion of the **Upper Legs** should be aligned with the slanted portion of the **Top Plate**.
- 3. Secure the **Upper Legs** to the **Top Plate**, using two **Nuts** for each side. Fasten the **Nuts** using the **Wrench**. (Figure 1)

**Note:** Align the outside edges of the **Upper Legs** with the outside edges of the **Top Plate** before tightening the **Nuts**.



- 4. Align the Screw Holes on the Lower Legs with the Screw Holes on the Upper Legs at the desired height adjustment setting.
- 5. Insert the Height-Adjustment Knobs through the Screw Holes on the Upper Legs and into the Screw Holes on the Lower Legs, then hand-tighten the Height-**Adjustment Knob**, being careful not to over-tighten.



- 6. Turn the Laptop Stand Assembly upright.
- 7. (Optional) Route the Laptop Cables through the Cable-Management Slots.

### **Operation**

**Height Adjustment** 

- 1. Disconnect the Laptop Cables, remove them from the Cable-Management Slots, and remove the **Laptop**.
- 2. Place the Laptop Stand Assembly, top side down, on a Clean, Flat, and Stable

**Note:** The lip on the **Top Plate** can overhang off the edge of the **Surface** for a level adiustment.

3. Remove the **Height-Adjustment Knobs** by turning each **Knob** counterclockwise.

**Note:** Ensure the **Upper Legs** are supported while removing the **Height Adjustment** Knobs.

- 4. Align the Screw Holes on the Lower Legs with the Screw Holes on the Upper Legs at the desired height adjustment setting.
- 5. Insert the **Height-Adjustment Knobs** through the **Screw Holes** on the **Upper** Legs and into the Screw Holes on the Lower Legs, then hand-tighten the Height-**Adjustment Knob**, being careful not to over-tighten.
- 6. Turn the Laptop Stand Assembly upright.

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
